## ABOUT OUR CONCERT & PERSONNEL

**Uttamlal "Tom" Shah**, who earned a master's degree in 1983 and a Doctor of Arts in music history in 1987 (both from the Ball State University School of Music), was among a dozen Americans killed in the August, 1998 bombing of the U.S. Embassy in Nairobi, Kenya. Shah studied jazz history and performance, trumpet performance, history and musicology, and was a graduate assistant to Larry McWilliams, then director of Ball State's Jazz Studies program. After graduation, Shah responded to an advertisement for government service.
